



## 2022 Plan Rates

Medical and dental plan rates will remain the same. **The vision Premier Plan has been enhanced and as a result will see a slight rate increase.**

## Medical Plans and Pharmacy

You have the choice of four medical plans through Florida Blue and UF Direct Health. The Blue Care HMO 65 Higher Deductible Plan has a **new \$40 copay** on Specialist and Mental Health office visits. Members enrolled in this plan will experience savings on these services as they previously applied to the plan deductible.

The UF Direct Health plan now has a **combined medical and pharmacy deductible and out-of-pocket maximum**. Members enrolled in this plan could experience savings by hitting their deductible or out-of-pocket maximum earlier.

Florida Blue members have their pharmacy benefits provided through Express Scripts. UF Direct Health members have their pharmacy benefits provided through **EngiveRX**.

## Dental Plans

You have the choice of four dental plans through Delta Dental. Plan design and rates remain the same. JPOFFHIT has absorbed the premium increase this year to keep your costs the same.

## Vision Plans

You have the choice of two vision plans through EyeMed. The Premier Plan has been enhanced to include a **\$0 copay** on eye exams, a **\$150 allowance** for frames and contacts and members can use the exam, lens and frame benefits **every 12 months**.

## Supplemental Plans

You have the choice of three supplemental plans through Unum. The Unum Critical Illness plan includes a **\$50 cash benefit** for eligible wellness exams for enrolled members. This benefit will now pay if you or your enrolled family members receive the COVID-19 vaccine.

## ID Cards

You will receive new ID cards if you elect a benefit for the first time or change plan types, such as switching from an HMO to a PPO.
